## Tokyo DisneySea Special Event “Harborside Christmas”

### Entertainment Programs

#### **Candlelight Reflections**

*Location: Mediterranean Harbor*

*Duration: Approx. 20 minutes*

*Performances: 1-2 Daily*

In the evenings, a fantastic waterborne Christmas tree of lights shines out to onlookers in the nighttime show “**Candlelight Reflections.**” The show begins with candles coming alight on the waters of Mediterranean Harbor while Christmas music plays. When Mickey Mouse and his friends appear, lighting numerous candles along the way, it’s time for the tree lighting ceremony to begin. The lights are dimmed and the music fades. In this expectant silence, stardust falls on top of the Christmas tree, making it shine and twinkle with numerous lights. Then, at a signal from the Disney friends, both the Cast Members and the guests come together as one as they raise their “lights,” creating a gorgeous “sea of lights” in Mediterranean Harbor. The show comes to a dramatic end with impressive pyrotechnics around the waterborne Christmas tree. (The Christmas tree will remain alight after the show, contributing to the romantic atmosphere at Mediterranean Harbor. The show “BraviSEAmo!” will not be performed during this period.)

#### “Candlelight Reflections” Finale

“Candlelight Reflections,” performed for the past six years, will be presented for the last time this year. To commemorate this finale, a “sea of lights” will be created at Mediterranean Harbor with the numerous lights held by both the Cast Members and the guests.

*Note: Merchandise for this “sea of lights” will be sold at shops in the Park. In addition, guests who purchase the “After 6 ‘Pair’ Passport” will receive a keychain (with glow stick). Guests who visit the Park on November 18 will also receive a complimentary item that glows (limited to one item per guest).*

#### **Big Band Beat Christmas Special**

*Location: Broadway Music Theatre*

*Duration: Approx. 30 minutes*

*Performances: 4-5 Daily*

“**Big Band Beat,**” the fantastic revue featuring swing jazz that was all the rage during the 1920s to the ’40s, will be performed during this period in a special Christmas version. The live band will perform jazzy arrangements of popular Christmas songs, as Goofy and Donald Duck make special guest appearances. Mickey and Minnie will also perform a romantic dance number for this holiday season. The show ends with the dancers dressed in Santa costumes singing Christmas songs together with the Disney friends.

**Character Greeting (title to be determined)**

*Location: American Waterfront*

*Duration: Approx. 30 minutes*

*Performances: 1-2 Daily*

Mickey, Minnie, and the Disney friends dressed in Christmas costumes will go around American Waterfront riding aboard a Big City Vehicle to give holiday greetings to the guests. Lively Christmas songs will enhance the holiday atmosphere in this fun greeting performance.

**Santa & Duffy's Holiday Greeting**

*Location: Next to Cape Cod Cook-Off*

Guests can take pictures with Santa Claus and Duffy at this photo location next to Cape Cod Cook-Off. The photo location will be decked for Christmas with a tree and wreaths.

**Mrs. Santa & Marie's Holiday Greeting**

*Location: Waterfront Park*

Guests can take pictures with Mrs. Santa and Marie at this photo location decorated for the holidays with bakery motifs.

**Christmas Wishes in the Sky**

A brilliant fireworks spectacular in Christmas colors of red and green will light the night sky as popular Christmas songs play.

**Other**

In addition to the above, "Meet & Smile," "Over the Waves," "Ariel's Greeting Grotto" and other regular shows and photo locations will be offered in Christmas versions. Moreover, "Fun Custodial," "Tokyo DisneySea Maritime Band" and other entertainers will perform Christmas songs to build up the holiday atmosphere. (The holiday version of "Over the Waves" starts from November 4.)

Note: Entertainment programs are subject to change or cancellation due to inclement weather, etc.

## **Decorations**

A Christmas tree approximately 15 meters tall will appear in front of the luxury liner *S.S. Columbia*. Also, the street leading from the Park entrance to Mediterranean Harbor will be decorated with colorful illuminations and designs of the Disney friends dressed for “Candlelight Reflections.”

## **Special Merchandise**

Approximately 90 different types of Tokyo DisneySea original merchandise will be offered, with designs of the Disney friends gathered in front of the “Candlelight Reflections” Christmas tree. There will also be “Decoration Rings” where guests can build their own unique ring by selecting Mickey- or tree-shaped parts and beads of their choice. In addition, the shops will offer approximately 170 different special merchandise items available at both Tokyo DisneySea and Tokyo Disneyland Parks, designed with snowmen and other Christmas motifs. (Special merchandise will be available from November 4. Items are available while supply lasts.)

## **Special Menus**

Special menus that come with souvenir items, and other special menus for Christmas will be available at Magellan’s, Ristorante di Canaletto, and other approximately 20 restaurants and food wagons within the Park. (Special menus will be available from November 4.)

## Tokyo Disneyland Special Event “Christmas Fantasy”

### Entertainment Programs

#### **White Holiday Parade**

*Location: Parade Route*

*Duration: Approx. 45 minutes*

*Performances: 2 Daily*

“**White Holiday Parade**” is a new, lively parade with the Disney characters enjoying the holiday season in a snowy winter wonderland. The first of the seven floats bring snowfall to the parade as Snow Mouse, Donald Duck and Daisy Duck frolic in the snow. Next is a float with Pooh and his friends, followed by the Toy Story characters, Mickey and Minnie happily skating, and a wonderful tea party with Alice and her friends. A Christmas tree float is followed by Santa Claus on a sleigh surrounded by presents. The parade also makes a stop, and when the elves show their jumping routine on trampolines, it’s time for everyone to join in the fun. Guests can shout and dance with the Disney friends as snow falls along the parade route for a joyous celebration of Christmas.

#### **Tokyo Disneyland Electrical Parade *Dreamlights***

*Location: Parade Route*

*Duration: Approx. 50 minutes*

*Performances: 1 Daily*

**Tokyo Disneyland Electrical Parade *Dreamlights***, a beautiful parade of lights spanning 700 meters, will be offered in a Christmas version. Mickey, Minnie, and the Disney characters will appear dressed in sparkling Christmas costumes. The floats will move along to favorite holiday tunes for a parade that is a delight to watch and a joy to listen to.

#### **Super-Duper Jumpin’ Time**

A holiday version of the kids’ show “**Super-Duper Jumpin’ Time**” will be performed at the Plaza Pavilion Bandstand, featuring Christmas elements in its puppet show and dance routine. New this year is a group of frogs happily singing Christmas carols with a humorous touch. (The holiday version starts from November 4.)

#### **“Christmas Wishes in the Sky”**

A brilliant fireworks spectacular in Christmas colors of red and green will light the night sky as popular Christmas songs play.

## **Other**

In addition to the above, the “Royal Herald Brass,” “Tokyo Disneyland Band” and other entertainers will also perform Christmas songs dressed for the season to build up the holiday atmosphere.

## **Decorations**

At the Main Entrance, guests will first encounter Mickey- and Minnie-shaped snowmen, as well as a flowerbed designed with Mickey wearing a Santa’s hat. On entering the Park, guests will find World Bazaar decked for the holiday with garlands and wreaths. At the center of World Bazaar will be a 15-meter-tall Christmas tree decorated with colorful ball ornaments, shining stars, and numerous lights. At the Plaza in front of Cinderella Castle, there will be three photo locations, each with a Disney pair – Mickey and Minnie, Donald and Daisy, and Goofy and Pluto – that rotate to melodies arranged in music box-style. At night, Cinderella Castle will be lit with images of snowflakes, bells and snowmen, casting a lovely and romantic atmosphere in the area.

## **Special Programs at Tokyo Disneyland Attractions**

### **The Disney Gallery – “Disney Drawing Class” Christmas Version**

At the **Disney Drawing Class**, guests learn how to draw popular Disney characters in a fun classroom setting. During the special Christmas version of the class, guests will learn to draw Mickey dressed as Santa, as well as Pluto dressed as a reindeer. Classes can be taken at **The Disney Gallery** in World Bazaar for a fee. (¥500 / approx. 30 minutes)
