**Kamigamo Jinja Shrine:**

Located in the Kita Ward of Kyoto, this is the oldest Shinto shrine in this ancient city which has a history of more than 1200 years as the capital. The current structure of the Shrine buildings was started in 678; most of the shrine complex (totaling 690,000m<sup>2</sup>) has been designated as Preservation Area of Historic Landscape by the municipal government and as a Historic Site by the national government; and on December 17, 1994, the shrine was officially registered as a World Cultural Heritages Site. The shrine is also famous for any number of events and festivals; chief among them is its role as the base for the famed *Aoi Festival* held every year in May, which is considered among the three most important festivals of the year in Kyoto. Despite its venerated place in history and its many attractions, it is not nearly as popular with visitors as one might expect, thus the area is much more tranquil, and exuding an atmosphere of peach.
