

New *Visitors' Information Centre* opens at the gateway to Osaka

Osaka City and Nankai Electric Railway Co., Ltd opened a comprehensive travel and information centre especially for international visitors at Nankai-Namba Station on April 25, as part of a joint venture between the two entities.

Located on the ground floor of the station, the *Visitors' Information Centre* is Osaka's first information centre to be opened in a joint public-private sector partnership.

English speaking staff are on hand at the centre daily between 9:00am and 8:00pm providing information about sightseeing spots, accommodation and the area's extensive transportation network.

The information centre is also equipped with a video phone system which supports a variety of languages including English, Korean, Chinese as well as sign language.

The information centre staff not only provide information and travel advice but can also assist with tour arrangements and train ticket reservations for visitors.

Visitors can also pick up information about the Nankai-Express *Koya* which links Namba - one of Osaka's gateways - with the World Heritage listed Koyasan, and receive help to create a comfortable and convenient itinerary for travel from Osaka.
